The purpose is to publish the recordings, to inform the public about the event organised by the Data Controller as an organisation responsible for the organisation of local cultural programmes and the dissemination of culture, and to present and promote the event, illustrating it with a photo report.</p> <p>A further aim is the transmission of records to Corvinus University as set out below.</p>
<p><b>Other information:</b></p>	<p>A crowd shot one where, when looking at the image, the identity of the individual is not significant, but the crowd as a whole carries information, but the participant may be recognisable in the image.</p> <p><b>The consent of the participant is not required for the bulk recording</b>, the legal basis for the processing is the legitimate interest of the Data Controller (Article 6(1)f GDPR), but the participant may object to the recording or to the use of the recording after the recording has been made. If the participant expressly intends to be recorded in front of the camera with the purpose of being individually depicted, the legal basis for the recording will be the participant's consent (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR). The Data Controller shall provide Corvinus with the image and video material of the event within 30, but no later than 60 working days after the event, whereby the Data Controller grants Corvinus University the right to use the images and video material. Corvinus shall display the images and video material provided to it primarily on its online platforms (website, facebook, instagram) in a planned manner in order to promote long-term cooperation and to reach the target audience of students. **Right of access (Article 15 GDPR)**

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the Controller feedback as to whether or not his or her personal data are being processed and, if such processing is taking place, right to access the personal data and information about the circumstances of the processing. Where personal data transferred to a third country or an international organisation, the data subject shall have the right to

be informed of the appropriate safeguards for onward transmission in accordance with Article 46. The Controller shall provide the data subject with a copy of the personal data which are the subject of the processing if the data subject so requests.

**Right to withdraw consent (Article 7 GDPR)**

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on consent prior to its withdrawal.

**Right to rectification (Article 16 GDPR)**

The data subject shall have the right obtain, at his or her request and without undue delay, correct inaccurate personal data relating to him or her.

**To object (Article 21 GDPR)**

The data subject has the right to object at any time, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, to the processing of his or her personal data on the basis of Article 6(1)(e) or (f) of the GDPR. In such a case, the Controller may no process the personal data unless it can demonstrate that the processing is justified on legitimate grounds which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject.

**Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 GDPR)**

The data subject shall have the right to obtain, at his or her request, the restriction of processing by the controller if any of the conditions set out in the GDPR are met, in which case the controller shall not perform any operation on the data other than storage.

If the data subject has objected to the processing; in this case, the restriction applies for the period until it is established whether the legitimate grounds of the Controller prevail over the legitimate grounds of the data subject.

**Right to erasure (right to be forgotten) (Article 17 GDPR)**

The data subject shall have the right to obtain the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay where the processing has no purpose, the data subject has withdrawn his or her consent and there is no other legal basis for the processing, there is no legitimate ground for processing which overrides the law in the event of an objection, the data have been processed unlawfully or the data must be erased in order to comply with a legal obligation. Where the controller has disclosed the personal data and is under an obligation to erase it, it shall take reasonable steps, including technical measures, taking into account the available technology and the cost of implementation, to inform the controllers that process the data that the data subject has requested the deletion of the links to or copies or replicas of the personal data in question.

**Right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR)**

The data subject is entitled to \_\_\_\_\_ the to \_\_\_\_\_ concerning him , by \_\_\_\_\_ the Data Controller the personal data provided to it is disaggregated and widely used,

in a machine-readable format, and has the right transmit these data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to whom he has disclosed the personal data, if legal conditions (automated processing and legal basis for consent or agreement) are met.

**Where and how can data subjects request detailed information about the processing and transfer of their data, and where and how can they exercise their rights?** The Data Controller draws the attention of data subjects to the that data subjects may request information, exercise their right of access and exercise their other rights by sending a statement to the postal or e-mail contact details of the Data Controller or Data Protection Contact. The Data Controller will examine and reply to the statement as soon as possible after receipt take the necessary steps as provided for in the statement, the Internal Privacy Policy and the law.
